November 4, 2025 – General and Special Elections

Deadline to register to vote:

- In person* Oct. 24 at 5 p.m.
- Online Oct. 24 at 11:59 p.m.
- By mail must be postmarked by Oct. 24

*Between October 25 and November 1, voters may submit a same-day registration and vote using a provisional ballot at an early voting location. On Election Day, November 4, voters may submit a same-day registration and vote using a provisional ballot at their precinct polling place.

Date when first Vote by Mail ballots will be mailed/mailed out..... Sept. 19

Deadline to apply to Vote by Mail:

- Online, in person, or by mail..... Oct. 24 at 5 p.m.

Deadline to return Vote by Mail ballots to be counted:

- Deposited in a drop box or hand delivered to office..... Nov. 4 at 7 p.m.
- Mailed ballot..... must be postmarked by Nov. 4 and received by noon on Nov. 7
